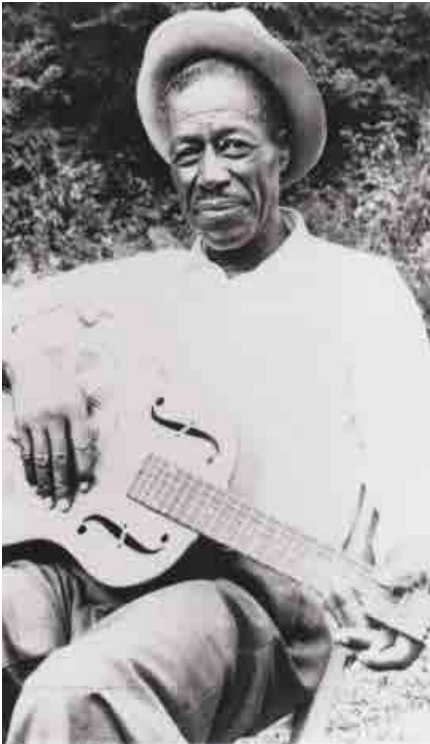
LYM DELTA RHYTHM KINGS SUNDAY 1 JULY

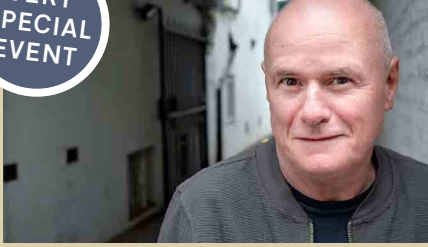
