REFUNDS

Tickets will not be refunded except in the event of a cancellation. Actors and musicians lead complicated lives, so please check our website before making a journey.

BOOKING FEES

These are not charged by the Marine. The Tourist Information Centres charge 50p on tickets up to £10 and £1 for tickets £10 and over. Online bookings at See Tickets have a 10% booking fee. To avoid a booking fee, tickets can be purchased from the Marine on Wednesday mornings.

VISITORS' INFORMATION

Normally the bar and box office open an hour before an event starts. The start time is when the event begins, which could be a support act. Child tickets are for those aged 16 and under. Unless stated, events are seated and the seating is unreserved.






