There is a 10% discount on tickets for members of the Marine Theatre. Please check for exceptions when booking.

IN PERSON

Advance tickets are available from the Marine on Mondays and Fridays from 10 A.M. until 1 P.M. and from Lyme Regis Bookshop and the Bridport Tourist Information Centre during opening hours. On the door tickets are available at the Marine from an hour before each show.

REFUNDS

Tickets will not be refunded except when an event is cancelled or postponed.

BOOKING FEES

These are charged by vendors to provide their services. The Lyme Regis Bookshop charges £1 per ticket. Tickets purchased online or from the Bridport Tourist Information Centre have a 10% booking fee. To avoid a booking fee, tickets can be purchased from the Marine on Monday and Friday mornings.

VISITORS' INFORMATION

Normally the bar and box office open an hour before an event starts.

The start time is when the event begins, which could be a support act. Unless stated, events have unreserved seating.

Our hearing loop lets you hear the performance more clearly through your hearing aid. You'll need to switch your hearing aid or CI to the hearing loop setting (also known as the 'T' setting or program). The signal from the hearing loop should cover all seating areas.

Carers receive a complimentary ticket when accompanying a ticket holder, but should show an access card with a +1 symbol on it.






