There is a 10% discount on tickets for members of the Marine Theatre. Please check for exceptions when booking.

IN PERSON

Advance tickets are available from the Marine on Mondays from 10 A.M. until 1 P.M. and from Lyme Regis Bookshop and the Bridport Tourist Information Centre during opening hours. On the door tickets are available at the Marine from an hour before each show.

REFUNDS

Tickets will not be refunded except when an event is cancelled or postponed.

BOOKING FEES

These are charged by vendors to provide their services. The Lyme Regis Bookshop charges £1 per ticket. Tickets purchased online or from the Bridport Tourist Information Centre have a 10% booking fee. To avoid a booking fee, tickets can be purchased from the Marine on Monday mornings.

VISITORS' INFORMATION

Normally the bar and box office open an hour before an event starts.

The start time is when the event begins, which could be a support act. Unless stated, events have unreserved seating.






